**JOB:**

1. To evaluate ALL the written essays

3. Pick the best-written essays on the topic.

**TOPIC:** WRITE A LETTER TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF NIGERIA INFORMING HIM OF THE PREVALENCE AND MENACE OF DRUG ABUSE; PROFFER SOLUTIONS TO TACKLE THIS HYDRA-HEADED CHALLENGE

**INTEREST/ENTRIES:** 627 students registered to participate in the competition out of which 156 candidates submitted their entries within the time limit (5<sup>TH</sup> June 2024)

**SUMMATION:**

The examiners are taxed to select the best ten written essays on the prevailing topic.

**CRITERIA/ MARKING SCHEME:**

1. **CONTENT:** This is the entire write-up on the topic. Bothering on the causes, effects, and the solution, and how the writer has woven his/her facts, using the right words to paint a picture of the scenario as it affects the individual and society.
2. **ORGANIZATION:** This is a list of the causes and effects of the discussion, with a probable solution to it.
3. **EXPRESSION:** This is the ability of the writer to paint a picture of how the phenomenon affects individuals and society in general.
4. **MECHANICAL ACCURACY:** This involves the ability of the writer to use punctuation marks and quotes for emphasis and embellishment.

**OTHER CRITERIA:** Registration on the stipulated portal within the time limit (31<sup>st</sup> May 2024)
